

Setting up a VPN

Setting up a VPN, like the free version of Windscribe, is generally straightforward. Most VPN providers, including Windscribe, offer dedicated apps for various devices that simplify the process to a few clicks: download, install, log in (or create an account), and connect.

Here's a more detailed guide using Windscribe as an example, along with general tips for using free VPNs:

Setting Up Windscribe (as an example of a free VPN)

1. Create an Account:

- Go to the Windscribe website (windscribe.com).
- Sign up for a free account. You'll typically get 2GB of data per month. You can often get more (e.g., up to 10GB with Windscribe) by providing and confirming your email address and sometimes by tweeting about the service.

2. Download and Install the App:

- Windscribe offers apps for various platforms like Windows, macOS, Android, iOS, Linux, and browser extensions for Chrome, Firefox, and Edge.
- Download the appropriate app for your device from their website or your device's app store.
- Follow the installation prompts.



3. Log In and Connect:

- Open the Windscribe app.
- Log in with the credentials you created.
- The app will usually present you with a list of server locations. Free plans typically offer a limited selection of locations.
- You can either choose a specific location or use the "Best Location" option, which generally connects you to the fastest server based on your current location.
- Click the "Connect" button (often a large power button icon).

4. Verify Connection (Optional but Recommended):

- Once connected, your IP address should change to that of the VPN server. You can verify this by searching "what is my IP address" on Google before and after connecting to the VPN
